Deuteronomy 1

Verses 22-25

- Do you remember the names of the two men who brought back the good report?

Verses 26-33

- What two things does verse 26 say the sons of Israel were doing against the LORD?
- What figurative language is used in verse 28? What does this mean?
- Where is God in our conflicts according to verse 30?
- What does verse 31 say God did for them?
- Did they trust Him when He did this?
- Who goes before us on our journey? Who lights our paths? Who guides us?

Verses 34-40

- When they didn't trust God, where did He detour them?

Verses 41-46

- What happened when God did not support their plan but they acted presumptuously?

Deuteronomy 2

Verses 1-7

- The people were sent into the wilderness due to their rebellion. Did God desert them there?
- Who had God given Mount Seir?
- What did the Israelites buy from these people?
- How long had they wandered?

Verses 8-15

- God did not promise land to the Israelites from what people-group?

Verses 16-25

- What other people-group would not lose land to the Israelites?
- What will happen to all the people everywhere according to verse 25?

Verses 26-31

- Why did God harden Sihon's spirit and made his heart obstinate?

Verses 32-37

- Who delivers our enemies into our hands?
- How many survivors were left?
