## John 2

## Verses 1-11

- Who is said to have been invited and attended the wedding in Cana?
- What happened at the wedding?
- Why did Jesus resist when pressed by Mary to help?
- What did she say in verse 5 that is basically the key to Christian life?

## Verse 12

• Who was with Jesus in Capernaum?

#### Verses 13-22

- Where did Jesus go for Passover?
- When Jesus became angry and ran the money changers out of the temple, what did He say they had made His Father's house?
- What is the application for us?
- What did Jesus prophecy in regard to His body, the temple?

## Verses 23-25

- What did many do during the feast of the Passover?
- What did Jesus know about mankind?

## John 3

## Verses 1-3

- Who was Nicodemus?
- If he was a Pharisee, would he be a religious man?
- What did Jesus say was required to see the kingdom of heaven?

## Verse 4-8

- What was Nicodemus's question? Was he truly trying to understand?
- Water would be the first birth, spirit would be the second or re-birth.

#### Verses 9-15

- Did Nicodemus, as a religious man, have the information he needed to understand this teaching? Didn't the law and the sacrifices point to Jesus?
- Nicodemus certainly would understand when Jesus spoke of lifting up the serpent in the wilderness. It pictures Jesus on the cross.
- What is the condition for receiving eternal life?
- It is also the insignia the medical field uses.

## Verses 16-21

- John 3:16 used to be the most well-known verse, but studies show now Matthew 7:1, "Judge not..." is now the most quoted verse. We will see this one later.
- How much does God love the world?
- Who will have eternal life? Are any excluded?
- What did men love rather than Light and why?
- Are we told if Nicodemus ever received Jesus? But, he was a moral and religious man, did he go to heaven? Think about this.

#### Verses 22-24

• Where were both John and Jesus baptizing before John was arrested?

## Verses 25-30

• Describe John's character.

## Verses 31-36

- What do those who are sent from God speak?
- How much of the Spirit does He give believers?
- What is the condition for eternal life?

## John 4

## Verses 1-6

- What are we told here about who was doing the baptizing? Any application for us here?
- Where did Jesus pass through on His way to Galilee?

## Verses 7-14

- Some backstory, the Jews and the Samaritans didn't get along. The Samaritans were a mixed race, Jew and Gentile, so the Jews believed them unclean. A Jewish man would never speak publicly with a woman or a Samaritan.
- Describe their discussion.

## Verses 15-26

- What did Jesus know about the woman's personal life?
- Salvation comes through which people?
- How will God's true worshipers worship?
- Who did Jesus say He was here? Has He revealed this previously?

## Verses 27-30

• What did the woman proclaim?

## Verses 31-38

• When Jesus says the fields are white for harvest, is He referring to food?

## Verses 39-42

- What did many do because of the woman's testimony?
- Think about it. We get so worked up about "witnessing", but a witness in a courtroom merely gives their testimony, what they have witnessed, seen, and heard. What is our application?
- Look at verse 42. They began to believe based on her testimony, then they experienced Him themselves!!

#### Verses 43-45

• How are prophets received among people who know them?

## Verses 46-54

- Whose son was sick? How sick?
- Did Jesus hurry off to the man's house?
- What did He do?
- Did the man believe?
- What happened to the man and his household because of the healing Jesus performed?
- What about you and me? Will we believe His words?
