## Leviticus 12

#### Verses 1-5

- What is the purpose for bleeding for a time after birth? The text will give you the word.

#### Verses 6-8

• Is concession made for a poor woman?

### Leviticus 13

#### Verses 1-6

- If a man suspects he has leprosy, who does he seek to confirm this? A doctor?
- How long is he isolated or quarantined?

#### Verses 7-8

• Leprosy is still around, called Hansen's Disease these days. More below.

#### Verses 9-39

• I have read through the Bible before, but I do not remember seeing eczema before.

#### Verses 40-44

• I also don't remember a discussion of baldness.

#### Verses 45-46

• Where do unclean people dwell? Do you remember where they took Nadab and Abihu when they died from offering strange fire?

#### Verses 47-52

How did they dispose of leprous clothing?

#### Verses 53-59

- Why do you think God spends so much time talking about leprosy? Uncleanness?
- Remember, He was giving instruction to a NEW nation, a nation that would be different from those around them, a nation that would be clean and pure.
