## Matthew 20

Verses 1-16

- Some have believed most of their lives and some come into the kingdom later in life. No one comes to the Father until He calls them. Salvation is in His timing. And yes, we receive the same reward.

Verses 17-19

- What specific things did Jesus tell the disciples would happen to Him?

Verses 20-28

- This is Matthew's account of the request of the sons of Zebedee. In his account, mom is involved.

Verses 29-34

- Matthew's account says there are two blind men but the story is the same.

## Matthew 21

Verses 1-5

- Where were they arriving in this passage?
- What were the disciples supposed to bring to Jesus?

Verses 6-8

- What did the people have handy for Jesus to sit upon? Do you think this says anything about the weather at the time?

Verses 9-11

- How was Jesus received in Jerusalem?

Verses 12-13

- "Robber's den" can also be translated "place of business".
- Is there any application for us?

Verses 14-17

- How did the chief priests and scribes respond to the way Jesus was received in Jerusalem?

Verses 18-22

- Any fruit tree that does not bear fruit is useless.
- Is there any application for us?

Verses 23-27

- How did Jesus respond to the question regarding His authority?

Verses 28-32

- Who did Jesus say would get into the kingdom of God before the religious men?

Verses 33-42

- What is the parable of the vine-grower about? What is the spiritual significance?

Verses 43-46

- From whom would the kingdom of God be taken away? Think about it, to whom was Jesus speaking at the time?
- Notice, it will be given to people who will produce fruit. Remember the problem with the fig tree?
- What did the Pharisees understand?
- What did they wish to do with Him? Why didn't they do this?
