# Verses 1-3

- What time reference is mentioned here?
- What did he see and what were they doing?
- Whom would they seal? But, if this is during what we call the Tribulation Period, why are there bond-servants (believers) there? Aren't they gone in the Rapture of the church? Of, are these men who became believers after the Rapture? Let's keep going and let Scripture tell us.

• How many from the tribes of Israel were sealed?

• How many believers were found and where were they from?

#### Verses 13-17

- What do you think of the paradox that the Lamb will be the shepherd?

# Verses 8-9

- What happened when the angel blew the second trumpet?
- How much of the sea was ruined? What happed to the sea creatures and ships?

# Revelation 9

## Verses 1-6

- What happened when the angel blew the fifth trumpet?
- What are the dimensions of this pit?
- What came out of the smoke from the pit?
- Did they harm the earth?
- What will men wish?

## Verses 7-11

- What were the locusts like? Some have speculated these to be military aircraft, the only way John could describe them in his day were like locusts. We don't know for sure.
- Who is the angel of the abyss?
- Abaddon means "destruction" in Hebrew and Apollyon means the same in the Greek.

#### Verse 12

• The fifth trumpet was the first woe after the eagle cried out.

# Verses 13-19

- What happened when the angel blew the sixth trumpet?
- What would the four angels who had previously been bound at the Euphrates River do?
- How many were in their army?
- How many would they kill?

# Verses 20-21

• Did these judgments cause mankind to repent (have a change of mind resulting in a change of direction) and turn to God?

## Verse 19

- Do you remember how Hebrews told us about the old covenant and the temple being mere shadows of the better covenant and the temple in heaven?
- Where is the temple mention in verse 19 located?
- What appeared inside it? Indiana Jones need not search for it, huh?
- What are we told about this temple that reminds you of what happened when the glory of the Lord entered the earthly temple?
