- The Pharisees sent their disciples to try and trick Jesus. How did they do this?
- What did Jesus perceive?
- How did Jesus respond to these men?

Verses 23-28

- What do Sadducees believe?
- Then why were they asking this question?

Verses 29-33

- Many people claim we turn into angels when we die. Notice this passage says in the resurrection we will be “like” angels in that we will not marry or be given in marriage.

Verses 34-40

- What is the greatest commandment?
- What depends on this statement?

Verses 41-46

- Why could no one answer Him?

Mark 12

Verses 1-12

- What is this parable about?
- What did they understand about this parable?

Verses 13-17

- Why were Pharisees and Herodians sent to Him?
- Jesus asked why they were testing Him, so how did He counter them?

Verses 18-27

- This is Mark's account. Are we given any additional information?

Verses 28-37

- Is there any additional information from Mark's account in this passage?

Verses 38-40

- What were the scribes like?
- What will they receive for their self-righteous behavior?

Verses 41-44

- Out of what do the scribes and Pharisees put into the treasury?
- What did the widow give?
