- Remember, "her" here is the great harlot, Babylon.
- What did the elders and the creatures do?
- What are they saying in verse 6?

Verses 7-8

- What is happening in these verses?
- We know who the Lamb is; His bride is the church.
- What does the fine linen represent?

Verses 9-10

- What is the testimony of Jesus?

Verses 11-16

- Who was riding upon this white horse? What is said of Him?
- John 1:1, "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God."
- Where are His armies found?
- What comes from His mouth that we've seen before?
- What name for Him is written along His thigh?

Verses 17-19

- What did this angel cry out?
- What did John observe about the beast and the kings of the earth?

Verses 20-21

- What happened to the beast and the false prophet?
- How had the false prophet deceive those who received the mark of the beast?
- The rest of who were killed? Remember the context is about the kings of the earth and their armies warring against the Lamb.

Revelation 20

Verses 1-3

- What was this angel holding?
- What did he do with the dragon? The text reminds us who this is.
- How long would the dragon be contained? Then what?

Verses 4-6

- What does John see next?
- Why had these people been beheaded?
- Who is blessed and how will they serve?

Verses 7-10

- What happens after the thousand years?
- What will satan do to the nations?
- What will be done with him in the end?

Verses 11-15

- “Then” is a time reference. It shows order. Then when? After what?
- What does this passage say about books?
- Are those who were lost at sea exempt from judgment?
- What happens to death and Hades?
- Where must a person’s name be written in order to avoid the lake of fire, where satan, the beast, and the false prophet are?

Revelation 21

Verses 1-4

- What did John see then?
- Why was there a need for a new heaven and a new earth?
- Where will God dwell?
- What will He do with our tears?

Verses 5-8

- What will those who overcome inherit?

- “Cowardly” here does not mean fearful in regard to a specific fear or general anxiety, it means one who shrinks back in fear of persecution for their testimony.
- Name other patterns of life which will cause a person to inherit the lake of fire.

Verse 9

- What would this angel show John?

Verses 10-14

- What city did John see?
- What twelve names were written on the gates?
- What was written on the foundation stones?

Verses 15-21

- What was this one who spoke with John doing?
- What were the gates and the streets like?

Verses 22-27

- Was there a temple in it?
- What are we told about the sun and the moon?
- What time of day will not be found there?
- Did you notice lying is mentioned again?
- Who are the only people which shall enter?

Revelation 22

Verses 1-5

- What was the river like?
- What tree was found there?
- What will be on the foreheads of His bond-servants?
- How will it be illuminated?

Verses 6-7

- What time references are used here and in what regard?

Verses 8-9

- John makes confirmation here of his vision and his writings.

- What did the angel say to John about worshiping him? We've seen this before. Is there application for us?

Verses 10-11

- What is John told here?

Verses 12-13

- Who is speaking now and what does He say?

Verses 14-15

- Who will enter the gates of the city and who will not?

Verse 16

- What does Jesus say about Himself?

Verse 17

- What do the Spirit and the bride say?

Verses 18-19

- What warning is given about the book of Revelation?

Verses 20-21

- Who testifies to the things written in Revelation and what does He say?
- How does John conclude this book?
