- Who was high priest at this time?
- What were the priests and elders plotting?
- What were they afraid might occur?

Verses 6-13

- What was wrong with Simon?
- What will we always have with us?
- How would this woman be remembered?

Verses 14-16

- Who initiated the deal between Judas and the chief priests?

Verses 17-19

- What did Jesus say in regard to the Passover preparations?

Verses 20-25

- What did Jesus say one of the disciples would do to Him?
- It had to happen but woe to whom?

Verses 26-29

- Of what were the bread and wine symbolic?

Verses 30-35

- What had been written about the disciples?
- What did Peter say and how did Jesus respond?
- Who else said this?

Verses 36-38

- Do you remember the sons of Zebedee? What were their names?
- What was Jesus experiencing emotionally at this point?

Verses 39-41

- What did Jesus pray?
- What were the disciples doing during this time?

Verses 42-46

- What is the time reference here?
- Who was coming?

Verses 47-50

- What was the signal?

Verses 51-54

- What happens to those who take up the sword? Note though, this is not in regard to self-defense.
- What must happen?

Verses 55-56

- To whom was Jesus speaking in this passage?
- Had they had plenty of opportunity to arrest Him?

Verses 57-64

- What kind of testimony did the Council seek?
- How did Jesus respond to their questions?

Verses 65-68

- On what grounds did the high priest claim Jesus deserved death?
- How did they treat their prisoner?

Verses 69-75

- Peter denied Jesus three times just as Jesus had said. How did Peter respond once he realized what he had done?

Mark 14

- This is Mark's account of the same time period.

Verses 1-11

- In Mark's account, we are told that this is when Judas began to plot against Jesus.

Verses 12-42

- According to verse 38, what is willing and what is weak?

Verses 43-52

- What are we told in verses 50 and 51 we weren't told in Matthew?

Verses 53-65

- Was Jesus talking about destroying the literal physical temple or His body?

Verses 66-72

- How do you think they recognized Peter as a Galilean?
- What are we told that Peter did in verse 71?
- Was Peter repentant?
