Verses 1-5

- The word "hate" here is a lesser degree of love. It's not what we would consider hate. God loves everyone. He expresses His love for Esau a lesser degree because Esau had become a foe.

Verses 6-14

- What was God's question about honor and respect?
- What were the people doing to the altar?
- Why wouldn't God accept their offering?

<u>Malachi 2</u>

Verses 1-9

- What did God say would happen if the people did not honor His name?
- Who stood in awe of God's name?
- What had they caused many to do according to verse 8?
- What were they doing in the instruction?
- What is our application?

Verses 10-12

- What were they doing with each other whilst profaning the covenant?
- What had they done to the sanctuary?

Verses 13-16

- Why did the people weep?
- The men were acting treacherously with the wife of their youth by accusing her of adultery so they cut put her away and receive another. The treachery was that a woman could be stoned for adultery.
- So, what is the context of God saying, "I hate divorce"?

• What had they done with their words?

- What would happen to the sons of Levi when the Lord appeared?
