• I'm going to do something different today. In order to appreciate the beauty of these Psalms, rather than breaking each passage down, I want you to read them through slowly, thinking about what they're saying as you go. Think about what's happening, how he feels, what he does about it. Notice David's emotion, how he begins and how he ends each Psalm. Think about what he's saying and what worries him. Think about how his situation can be applied to our lives. Don't forget to take note of what you learn about God and His character. Chapter 56, verse 3 is key. Though a valiant warrior, he doesn't pretend like he never experiences fear, but tells us where he turns when he experiences fear. Did David have a reason to be afraid?
