• Gilgal means "circle of stones". Why do you think it has this name based on what we saw yesterday?

- What does this passage tell us about the manna God used to feed them for 40 years?

Verses 13-15

- If Joshua met the captain of the host of the LORD, whom did he meet? Any idea?
- What did he say to Joshua? Have you heard this before?

Joshua 6

Verses 1-5

- Why was Jericho tightly shut? Had they heard about the miraculous things God had done for them?
- What did the LORD say to Joshua about the city of Jericho?
- What would they have to do to obtain it? Does this sound quite ridiculous?

• What is the point of doing all of this? How do you think the people inside the walls were responding? Do you remember that Rahab had a house on the wall? People who had houses on the wall could see out.

Verses 16-21

• Did Achan readily admit what he had done?

• What is the third word in verse 21? Does this remind you of Eve? Genesis 3:6, "When the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was a delight to the eyes, and that the tree was desirable to make *one* wise, she took from its fruit and ate; and she gave also to her husband with her, and he ate."

Verses 22-26

• What did the people do with Achan? But, in verse 15, God said he should be burned with fire.

<u>Ioshua 8</u>

Verses 1-2

• I want you to notice, in the Bible, every time it says not to fear, it is in preparation for something coming, or in response to an angel surprising a person, or the fear of battle. It is ALWAYS used to comfort and NEVER meant to condemn. Everyone is fearful at times. It is an emotion God gave us to keep us safe from danger. God does not condemn us for experiencing fear; however, walking in fear apart from trusting is to Him is sinful. Experiencing fear is not sinful; but where we run when we're afraid can be sinful and will definitely tell where our faith lies.
