- Do you remember in what city they were in at this time?
- Where did Jesus say He would meet up with the brethren?

Verses 11-15

- Why did the chief priest bribe the soldiers?
- Proverbs 17:23 says, "A wicked man receives a bribe from the bosom to pervert the ways of justice."
- What does this say about the character of these moral men?

Verses 16-20

- Why are there now only eleven disciples?
- What did they do when they saw Him?
- I have heard people say we are to only worship God, therefore, worshipping Jesus is idolatry. Who is Jesus? Is He worthy of worship?
- What charge did Jesus give His disciples? Did He say go make converts or disciples? What is the difference?
- If believers are disciples of Jesus, what is our application?

- If you have had a personal experience with Jesus, where He revealed Himself to you, do people always believe you?

Verses 12-13

• What if others have a similar experience, do people always believe them?

Verses 14-18

• Why did Jesus reproach the eleven? What caused their unbelief?

Verses 19-20

- Where did Jesus go after speaking to the disciples?
- What did they do when He left them?
