- Where did Mary focus her attention?
- In what way was Martha distracted?
- Was there anything wrong with seeking to be a good hostess?
- Why was Martha annoyed?
- Who chose the necessary and good part?

### Verses 22-30

- What do we learn about the seasons in regard to the Feast?
- Why did these men not believe Jesus was the Christ?
- List the things He says about His sheep?
- What does verse 30 say?

## Verses 31-42

- If the Jews picked up stones to stone Him, does this imply they understood what He was saying in regard to His deity?
- The religious men believed Jesus was blaspheming, so what were the seeking to do to Him?
- What does verse 42 say about Him?
