## 1 Chronicles 10

Verses 1-6

- Here we pick up again from where Saul and Jonathan were killed.
- Do you remember the fellow who came to David and claimed he found Saul and finished him off? Was he telling the truth according to this passage and the passage from 1 Samuel?
- Now we saw before the statement that all those of Saul's house died together. This was speaking of those of Saul's house on the battlefield together. We know from previous studies Saul had other sons who did not join them in battle.

Verse 7

- What happened to the Israelites when Saul died?
- What did the Philistines do?

Verses 8-10

- What did the Philistines do to Saul and his armor?

Verses 11-12

- What did the men of Jabesh-gilead do to honor Saul?

Verses 13-14

- Why does this passage say Saul died?
- Think about this, Jonathan was not personally guilty of the things Saul did, yet he was killed as well. Do the decisions of our leaders affect our well-being? Do they effect of standing before God on a national level?
