- Ezekiel 16:48-50 tells us, "As I live," declares the Lord GOD, "Sodom, your sister and her daughters have not done as you and your daughters have done. Behold, this was the guilt of your sister Sodom: she and her daughters had arrogance, abundant food and careless ease, but she did not help the poor and needy. Thus they were haughty and committed abominations before Me. Therefore I removed them when I saw it." So, despite what we've always believed, Sodom was destroyed for her arrogance and apathy. The behavior of the men from Genesis is an outward expression of the inward arrogance.
