## Deuteronomy 14

Verses 1-2

- What were the Israelites not supposed to do? Why were they doing this?

Verses 3-8

- Have we seen the instructions on clean and unclean foods before?

Verses 9-21

- Why do you think they were not supposed to eat an animal that died on its own?

Verses 22-27

- A tithe is 10%. Of what items were they supposed to tithe?
- How did the LORD make concession for people who live far away?

Verses 28-29

- What was the purpose of the tithe at the end of every third year?

## Deuteronomy 15

Verses 1-6

- What happens to debt at the end of seven years?
- What does verse 4 say about the poor?

Verses 7-11

- How was an individual supposed to support a poor person?
- What should the lender NOT be thinking when lending to a poor person?

Verses 12-17

- This is not talking about forced slavery. In these days, if a person owed a debt, he could sell himself to pay off the debt. Review how this servant was to be treated and in what condition is he set free?

Verses 18-23

- Do you remember all the previous instruction on the firstborn?

## Deuteronomy 16

Verses 1-8

- This is the Passover instruction given previously.
- Below are previously given instructions on the other feasts.

Verses 9-20

- How were judges supposed to conduct themselves?

Verses 21-22

- We saw this before. Asherah was the mother-goddess of the Canaanites. Her pole looked like a tree. Worship of Asherah was pagan and associated with worship of nature.
