- What would a polished sword represent, say, in contrast to a rusty sword?

Verses 11-17

- What will happen when He claps His hands together?

Verses 18-23

- What tool of war is mentioned in verse 22?

Verses 24-32

- To whom is this last paragraph prophesied?
- Ammon in modern-day Jordan.
