- As you read through these Psalms, remember to make note of what you learn about God.

### Psalm 81

Verses 1-16

- What ancient instruments are mentioned in this psalm?
- Which celebrations are mentioned?
- Who is speaking from verse 6 and following?
- Observe verse 15. Do the pretenders love the LORD?

### Psalm 88

Verses 1-18

- What emotion is used by this psalmist? What is going on for him?
- What does his support system look like according to verse 8?
- What does verse 13 tell us about his persistence in prayer?

### Psalm 92

Verses 1-15

- Which name for God is used in verse 1?
- Which instruments are used in this psalm? A lute is a stringed instrument which a musician plucks, similar to a guitar.
- What kinds of men are named in verse 6?
- Is there any unrighteousness in God?

### Psalm 93

Verses 1-5

- What kinds of things are used to describe God's clothes? What does it mean that He is clothed in these things? Is this literal or figurative language?
- When was His throne established?
- What has lifted up its voice in verses 3 and 4? Do floods have voice? What does this mean?
- What is a testimony? Think about what happens in a courtroom. See you tomorrow.
