- What was Elijah's ultimatum in verse 21?
- How would they prove God?

Verses 25-29

- What happened when they called on Baal?

Verses 30-35

- How did Elijah prepare his offering?

Verses 36-40

- What was Elijah's prayer?
- What did he want God to show the people?
- What was the result?

Verses 41-46

- I chuckled at the visual picture I got from verse 46.

## 1 Kings 19

Verses 1-8

- What was Jezebel's threat to Elijah?
- How did Elijah feel about this threat according to verse 3? So even God's heroes become fearful at times?
- What did he ask of God while sitting under the Juniper tree? Why would he ask this?
- How was Elijah strengthened?

Verses 9-10

- What name of God is used here? This is the name of God that means He is over the armies of angels in heaven.
- What had Israel done? Not done? Sought to do?

Verses 11-14

- Does this remind you of the time God revealed His glory to Moses?

Verses 15-18

- God does nothing without first revealing it to His prophets according to Amos 3:7.
- God always leaves a remnant.

Verses 19-21

- What did Elijah place on Elisha? Does this remind you of the exchanging of the robes between David and Jonathan?
- Then what happened?
