Verses 4-7

- What did Moses say God will do tomorrow?

Verses 8-11

- What had God done for the Levites He had not done for the rest of the congregation?
- Who did Moses defend in this passage?

Verses 12-14

- Did Dathan and Abiram come immediately when summoned?

Verses 15-19

- We have seen Moses intercede for these people many times, why is he not doing so now?
- How many of the people did Korah incite against them?

Verses 20-22

- What did God intend to do to the congregation?

Verses 23-24

- What did the LORD warn the congregation to do?

Verses 25-30

- The men stood at the doorway of their tents with whom else?
- What would be the sign between these men and Moses?

Verses 31-35

- What happened to Korah and his men and their families? Think about this. Does our sin affect our children?

- What happened to the men offering incense?

Verses 36-40

- What was to be done with the censers (for the incense)?
- Of what was this a reminder?

Verses 41-50

- The people were shocked by what happened to Korah and the others, but did that change them? What did they do the very next day?
- What did God intend to do to the people? In what way?
- What did Moses ask Aaron to do quickly?
- How many people died before atonement was made?

Verses 1-7

- What was Moses to obtain from the sons of Israel? What was he to write on them?
- What will happen to the rod of the man God chooses?

Verses 8-11
