1 Samuel 25

Verse 1

- What did the people do when Samuel died? What does this tell us about his character and reputation?

Verses 2-8

- What are we told about Nabal? What was he like? He was from whose family?
- What are we told about his wife, Abigail?
- What was David asking for his men?

Verses 9-13

- Was Nabal generous with his goods?

Verses 14-17

- What report did the young man give Abigail?
- How did this servant feel about Nabal?

Verses 18-22

- What did Abigail do when she heard the report?

Verses 23-25

- Nabal means “fool”.
- Abigail means “my father’s joy”.

Verses 26-31

- Does it seem Abigail has faith in the LORD?

Verses 32-35

- What did David say her actions had prevented?
- Would you say she acted wisely? What did her husband’s name mean?

Verses 36-38

- What happened in this passage?

Verses 39-42

- Who avenged David?
- What did David send Abigail?
- Did she accept?

Verses 43-44

- While it was culturally accepted at the time, polygamy was never instituted by the LORD.

1 Samuel 26

Verses 1-5

- Who told Saul where to find David?
- How did David know Saul was coming?

Verses 6-12

- Who went with David into Saul's camp?
- What did David have the opportunity to do?
- Observe verse 9. Have we seen David say something similar before?
- Don't forget, every believer is God's anointed.
- Who caused the sound sleep?

Verses 13-16

- Then what did David do?

Verses 17-20

- Observe verse 19. What do you think of this?

Verses 21-25

- How did Saul respond? Have we seen this before?
- Do you think their relationship was on the mend?

1 Samuel 27

Verses 1-4

- To where did David flee?
- Did Saul pursue him there? Why did or didn't he?

Verses 5-7

- How long did David live in Ziklag?

Verses 8-12

- Not the phrase, "they were the inhabitants of the land from ancient times". What should have happened to these people earlier so they would not be a snare at this point?
- How did David make this right in verses 9 and 11?
- What did Achish believe?
