- Psalm 119 is the longest psalm in the Bible, containing 176 verses. Psalm 119 is an acrostic poem. It has 22 stanzas, one for each of the letters of the Hebrew alphabet listed at the beginning of each stanza. This is how they would remember it to recite it orally. Enjoy the first 88 verses here.
