- Scholars believe the “time of Jacob’s distress” is the Great Tribulation Period.

- Is this true now or still a future prophecy?

Verses 23-24

- “Until” and “latter days” are time references.

Jeremiah 31

Verse 1

- At what time?

Verses 2-3

- If God says He has an everlasting love, will He ever quit loving Israel? Will He ever quit loving us?

Verses 4-9

- Ephraim is another name for Israel, used because Ephraim was a large tribe.

Verses 10-15

- Ramah is in Israel, an area belonging to the tribe of Benjamin.

Verses 16-17

- What is there for their future? Can a person survive without hope?

Verses 18-21

- What is the purpose of a roadmark or a guidepost?

Verses 22-28

- “Days are coming”. This means still future and is in regard to the new covenant.

Verses 29-30

- Are we responsible for the actions of others, our ancestors, our family members?

Verses 31-34

- Ezekiel 36:26, “I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; and I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.”

Verse 35

- If God has fixed the order of the sun, moon, and stars, do we need to fear their demise?

Verses 36-40
