## Zechariah 1

Verses 1-6

- What is the timing of this passage? Do you remember the timing of Haggai?
- What does this tell us in regard to God speaking to His prophets?
- Who did the LORD say the people were not to be like?
- Did they listen?

Verses 7-11

- What is the time reference here?
- On what was the man in the vision riding?
- What was behind him? Who were they?
- What does this tell us about the man standing among the myrtle trees?

Verses 12-17

- Have we ever seen the angel of the LORD in other Scriptures? Do you remember anything about him?
- What would be built when the LORD returns to Jerusalem with compassion?

Verses 18-21

- What are the four horns according to the passage?
- Is there any other Scripture we read about horns? Do you remember?
- What would the craftsmen do?

## Zechariah 2

Verses 1-5

- What was the man with the measuring line going to do?

Verses 6-12

- What does God consider Israel according to verse 8?
- Do you remember that the name the LORD of hosts signifies the God of heaven's armies?

Verse 13

- What would silence before the LORD signify?

## Zechariah 3

Verses 1-5

- Where was satan standing?
- What was his purpose for being there?
- So, if satan is our accuser, then we point fingers at others, we are helping do his work.
- This is very important... Who rebukes satan?
- What is the application for us?
- How was Joshua clothed?
- Watch the wording here, who has taken iniquity away? (From previous Scriptures, who is this?)

Verses 6-7

- Admonish means to warn or reprimand. Does the angel of the LORD have the authority to admonish?
- An “if” is always followed by a “then”, even if it’s just implied. What is the “if” and what is the “then”?

Verses 8-10

- Jesus is the Righteous Branch. See Jeremiah 23:5, and 33:15.
- Have we seen “In that day” before in Scripture?

## Zechariah 4

Verses 1-7

- What did the angel of the LORD do to Zechariah?
- What did he see?
- Not by might, nor by power, but by what?

Verses 8-10

- Who laid the foundation and will also finish the house?
- Does this agree with other accounts?

- Do you know what a plumb line does?

Verses 11-14

- “Olive” as a name means “Peace”. Olive oil was used for anointing.
- Keeping the lampstands full of oil was a daunting task. These lampstands which seem to be in unlimited supply is thought to signify the continual burning of the light by God’s spirit. The two olive trees are thought to be the offices of the kings and priests as well as a picture that Jesus is the light of the world and Christians bear His light into the world.

## Zechariah 5

Verses 1-4

- Why would you think a scroll would contain a curse?
- Do you find it interesting the thief and the one swearing falsely by His name are mentioned together?

Verses 5-11

- Who was still speaking with Zechariah?

## Zechariah 6

Verses 1-8

- What was coming forth from the mountains?
- Some scholars believe these are The Four Horsemen of Revelation.

Verses 9-10

- What was Zechariah supposed to take from the exiles?

Verses 11-15

- The name Jesus is the New Testament equivalent of the Old Testament name Joshua.
- Did you notice the Branch mentioned here again? And that the priest is also on a throne (king)? The two offices mentioned previously.

## Zechariah 7

Verses 1-7

- What is the timing here?
- Do you remember over which nation he is king?
- Verse five tells how long the exiles have been in captivity? Does this number of years confirm prophesy?

Verses 8-14

- What had the LORD of hosts said according to verse 9?
- Had the people paid attention?
- Why did the LORD refuse to listen when they called?
- What did He do with them instead?
