• In what year after they people came out of Egypt did Aaron die?

Verses 40-56

- What were the sons of Israel supposed to do to the inhabitants of the land? Why? Hint: verse 52. What is the application for us?
- How would the land be divided?
- What is the spiritual significance of verse 55?

Verses 1-12

• If you mapped out these borders, are the sons of Israel inhabiting ALL the land God promised them today?

Verses 13-15

• Do you remember from yesterday the request of the tribes of Reuben, Gad, and the half tribe of Manasseh?

Verses 16-29

- Which two men were to apportion the land?
- Who was mentioned from the tribe of Judah? Do you remember anything about him from before? See you tomorrow.
