Exodus 7

Verses 1-7

- In verse one, God is saying that Moses will speak for God and Aaron will speak for Moses.
- What does this passage say is the purpose for God hardening Pharaoh's heart?
- How "great" things will God use to bring the people out of Egypt?
- What will these "great" things cause the Egyptians to know about God?
- How old were the brothers when they spoke to Pharaoh? Remember, this is not the same Pharaoh in whose house Moses was raised.

Verses 8-13

- What will Aaron's staff become?
- What were the wise men, sorcerers, and magicians able to do with their secret arts? Our enemy, the devil, often mimics the work of God, for he wishes to be worshiped.
- What Pharaoh convinced when Aaron's serpent overtook the other serpents?

Verses 14-19

- What would God turn the Nile into?
- What will happen to the river life after this?

Verses 20-25

- Did Moses and Aaron obey God?
- Did everything happen just as God had said?
- What did the magicians of Egypt do?
- How did this affect Pharaoh?

Exodus 8

Verses 1-7

- If the Nile turning to blood was the first plague/judgment of God upon Egypt, what was the second?
- Were the magicians able to mimic God's work with their secret arts?

Verses 8-9

- Although the text tells us Pharaoh's magicians were able to bring forth frogs (Were they really if God had already started bringing them forth?), Pharaoh seems to acknowledge they came from God.

- What did Pharaoh want Moses and Aaron to ask of the LORD?
- What did he say he would do in return?

Verses 10-15

- What did God do when Moses requested the frogs be removed to the Nile?
- Did Pharaoh keep his word?

Verses 16-19

- What was the third plague/judgment?
- Were the magicians able to bring forth gnats?
- What did the magicians acknowledge to Pharaoh?

Verses 2-24

- What was the fourth plague/judgment?
- What part of Egypt would not be affected by the flies?
- What was this division supposed to show the Egyptians?

Verses 25-29

- When Pharaoh called for Moses and Aaron, where did he tell them, in compromise, they could go worship God?
- Think about this. Egypt was full of idols/false gods, would it be acceptable to sacrifice to God there?
- Pharaoh asks them to make supplication for him. Supplication is asking earnestly for something.
- On what condition did Moses say he would make supplication for Pharaoh?

Verses 30-32

- Did Pharaoh relent?

Exodus 9

Verses 1-7

- In verse one, God says He is the God of what people group?
- What was the fifth plague/judgment?
- Did the division of the livestock cause Pharaoh to relent?

Verses 8-12

- What was the sixth plague/judgment?
- What did Moses and Aaron do in the sign of Pharaoh?
- Though both man and beast were affected, this Pharaoh change his mind?

Verses 13-17

- Why had God allowed them to remain?
- Who did Pharaoh exalt?

Verses 18-21

- What was the seventh plague/judgment?
- What is contrast between those who feared the LORD and those who didn't?

Verses 22-26

- Who rained hail on Egypt? Was it Mother Nature? Was it the devil?
- What was different about his hail?
- How did the hail affect the land?
- What land was safe from the hail?

Verses 27-35

- What does Pharaoh finally acknowledge in verse 27? About himself? About God?
- To whom does the earth belong?
- Though Pharaoh wanted the judgments to cease, what does Moses say about Pharaoh in verse 30?
- What grain was spared from the hail?
- What was Pharaoh's "sin" equated with in verse 34?
- Have you ever cried out to God in distress, then when the pressure has subsided, go right back to our daily life unchanged?
- Notice how the men under Pharaoh's leadership responded once Pharaoh hardened his heart.
