Verses 1-5

- This passage starts with “then”. How would you find out then when?
- Who was Rehoboam? Do you remember? Who was his father? Keep reading.

Verses 6-11

- Did Rehoboam listen to the counsel of his elders?
- How did the young men counsel him?

Verses 12-15

- On what day did the men return to Rehoboam?
- How did the king answer them? Under whose advice?
- Who was in charge of this turn of events? For what reason?

Verses 16-19

- Because of Rehoboam’s harsh words, who were the Israelites in rebellion against?

Verse 20

- Who did Israel make king over them?
- Which tribe continued under Rehoboam?
- Is this exactly as the LORD had told Solomon would happen due to his idolatry?

Verses 21-24

- What did the LORD say in regard to fighting between the house of Israel?

Verses 25-33

- What was Jeroboam’s thinking process in this passage?
- Under Jeroboam, did the people worship God in the way God required?

1 Kings 13

Verses 1-10

- What did the man of God from Judah cry out?
- What was the sign of which the LORD had spoken?
- What happened to Jeroboam's hand? How was it healed?

Verses 11-19

- How did the old prophet convince the man of God from Judah to return with him?

Verses 20-25

- What happened to the man of God from Judah?

Verses 26-32

- Samaria was the capitol of the divided kingdom of Israel.

Verses 33-34

- What happened to the house of Jeroboam?

1 Kings 14

Verses 1-3

- Who were the two Abijah's in this passage?

Verses 4-5

- What information did the LORD give Abijah before the arrival of Jeroboam's wife?

Verses 6-14

- Who had made Jeroboam leader over Israel, tearing it from the house of David?
- What did God say Jeroboam's character was like?
- Who brings calamity? But, that's a bad thing. Does God do bad things?
- What would happen to the child, Abijah? What is said of the child?

Verses 15-16

- Who will give up Israel? Why?

Verses 17-20

- How long did Jeroboam reign?
- Who reigned in his place?

Verse 21-24

- Meanwhile, Rehoboam is leading in the nation of Judah.
- Jerusalem was the capitol of Judah.
- How long did he reign?
- What is said of his character?
- What despicable (abomination) thing was going on in regard to the worship of the false gods?
- Of what are their acts compared?

Verses 25-28

- What did Shishak take?
- With what did Rehoboam replace the shields of gold?

Verses 29-31

- What was the relationship like between Rehoboam and Jeroboam? Between Israel and Judah, the divided kingdom?
- Who succeeded Rehoboam?
