• The following passages describe the territory given to the sons of Joseph; Ephraim and Manasseh. This chapter focuses on Ephraim.

Verses 1-10

 What happened to the Canaanites who lived in Ephraim's territory? What had God said about conquering these territories in regard to the people groups living there, do you remember?

Joshua 17

• This chapter focuses on the other of Joseph's sons, Manasseh.

Verses 1-6

 What did the daughters request from Eleazar? Do you remember when they went before Moses with this request?

Verses 7-13

• What happened to the Canaanites in this territory? Please remember this last phrase for later. What happens when we don't drive the enemy out completely?

Verses 14-18

• In what way would Ephraim and Manasseh be able to spread out? Remember, though they are numerous, this is only the ½ tribe of Manasseh. The other half remained opposite the Jordan River.

Verses 2-7

• Observe verse 3. Now read it again.

- God has made everything available to believers which pertain to life and godliness (2 Peter 1:3). When are we going to take possession of what is available to us?
- According to verse 6, what determined how the rest of the territory was divided?

Verses 8-10

• What did Joshua ask of the three men from each tribe? (21 men total, since there were 7 tribes left)

Verses 11-20

- Whose tribe's territory would fall between Judah and the sons of Joseph?
- According to verse 19, where did the southern border end?

Verses 21-28

• As always, you are welcome to look these borders up on a map if you wish.
