Verses 9-14

- To whom did He tell this parable?
- Where was their faith?
- What do we call this kind of righteousness?
- How does self-righteousness cause us to view others?
- Who are the two men who are contrasted in this passage?
- What was the prayer of the Pharisee like?
- What was the prayer of the tax collector like?

- What happens to those who exalt themselves? Is this what the religious man was doing, exalting himself?
- What happens to those who humble themselves?
- Is there any application here for us?
