Verses 1-8

- What did Hezekiah do in verse five? What does it say he needed to do this?
- Where have you heard the words from verse 7 before?
- What encouragement did Hezekiah give the people in verse 8?

Verses 9-15

- Do you remember in which book we read this before?

Verses 16-19

- What was the purpose of the letters?
- In what way did they speak of God?

Verses 20-23

- This passage answers the question I asked about in which other book this story is written.
- What happened to the soldiers from Assyria?
- What happened to Sennacherib when he returned home in shame? You may want to take a minute to research this and see how history supports biblical accounts.

Verses 24-31

- We read this in parallel passages.

Verses 32-33

2 Chronicles 33

- This is a parallel passage from 2 Kings.

Verses 1-9

- Where did Manasseh put this idol?

Verses 10-13

- How did the people respond when God spoke?
- “Therefore” (because they wouldn’t listen), what happened?
- On whom did they use meat hooks?
- How did this change Manasseh?

Verses 14-17

- Did the people follow Manasseh’s lead?

Verses 18-20

- Who succeeded Manasseh?

Verses 21-25

- What was Amon like?
- What happened to him?
- Who became king after that?
