Leviticus 8

Verses 1-5

- Where did God tell Moses to assemble the people?
- Notice our church words “assemble” and “congregation”.

Verses 6-13

- Do you find it interesting the whole assembly of people were asked to witness these ceremonies?

Verses 14-17

- In what way does the last phrase of this passage say Moses did these things?

Verses 18-21

- In what way does the last phrase of this passage say Moses did these things?

Verses 22-29

- Why do you think the blood was put on their ears, their hands, and their toes?
- What is the name of this offering? Notice our church word “ordination”?
- In what way does the last phrase of this passage say Moses did these things? Why do you think God repeats this?

Verses 30-36

- How long were they to remain at the doorway?

Leviticus 9

Verses 1-7

- What were the names of the offerings on the eighth day?
- What was their purpose?

Verses 8-24

- What did Aaron do for the people after the offerings? (verse 22)
- What did he and Moses do after coming out of the tent of meeting?

- What did God do with the offering?
- How did the people respond? Hebrews 12:29, “For our God is a consuming fire.”

Leviticus 10

Verses 1-2

- What kind of fire did Nadab and Abihu offer?
- Do you remember Exodus 30:6-9, “Place the altar in front of the veil that is before the ark of the Testimony—before the mercy seat that is over the Testimony—where I will meet with you. And Aaron is to burn fragrant incense on it every morning when he tends the lamps. When Aaron sets up the lamps at twilight, he must burn the incense perpetually before the LORD for the generations to come. On this altar you must not offer unauthorized incense or a burnt offering or grain offering; nor are you to pour a drink offering on it.”
- What happened to Nadab and Abihu when they did this? Had they been warned?

Verse 3

- According to Moses’s words to Aaron, how were Nadab and Abihu NOT treating the LORD by offering a strange sacrifice?
- Is it possible Aaron remained silent from fear? From grief?

Verses 4-7

- Why do you think this passage mentions Nadab and Abihu were still in their tunics when they were carried outside the camp? Just think about this. What would be the message for the people?
- Do you remember what they took from the sacrifices and placed outside the camp? Is it possible this was like the local dump? A place for trash, rubble, and refuse?
- Why were they not to uncover their heads or tear their clothes? Of what was this a sign? Why do you think God didn’t want them to grieve for these men?
- They weren’t to grieve the men, but what were they to grieve?

Verses 8-11

- How might wine or strong drink keep the priests from making distinctions between holy and profane, so as to teach the sons of Israel?

Verses 12-15

- What is the last phrase of this passage?
- What is the example for us?

Verses 16-20

- Think this through, why did Aaron's words seem good to Moses? Read it a couple of times if you must.
- Did Moses overreact? Was he being thorough? Just meditate on this. See you tomorrow.

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
