Verses 1-6

- Tyre was a northern neighbor to Israel in. It lied on the Mediterranean in southern Lebanon. It was a Phoenician seaport city from about 2000 BC through the Roman times.
- Hiram reigned from 939-936 BC.

- Sidon is another Mediterranean city in Lebanon.

- What did Hiram recognize about Solomon's character?
- How did Hiram deliver the timber to Solomon?
- Describe the relationship between Solomon and his neighbor, Hiram.

Verses 13-18

- Describe the worker's rotation,
- Where did the men obtain the stones for the foundation of the temple?

1 Kings 6

Verses 1-6

- When the building of the temple began, how many years had it been since the Israelites had been delivered out of Egypt?
- How many years had Solomon been king at this time?

Verses 7-10

- What were the stairs like?
- Where did Solomon get the planks and timbers of cedar?

Verses 11-13

- What was God's promise to Solomon?
- Was this promise conditional?

- If you notice, cedar is mentioned a good bit here. This is probably why God gave us the story about Solomon and Hiram.

• Maybe you remember talking about the cherubim when we read about the tabernacle, but if not, we should know cherubim (-im just means the word is plural, so there are more than one) are not weak childlike baby-form angels. They are strong and powerful. They guard the entrance to the Garden of Eden so no one can enter there and partake of the Tree of Life.

• When was the foundation laid? The fourth year of what? Start at the top of today's reading if you don't know.

• What does Hiram acknowledge about God in this passage? How would he know about God?

Verses 13-18

• Aliens in Scripture are not from outer space. An alien is a foreigner, he is alien to the country he is in.

2 Chronicles 3

Verses 1-2

- Where did Solomon begin to build the temple?
- Mount Moriah is the same mountain range where Abraham obeyed God in offering Isaac as a sacrifice, though God did not allow any harm to come to Isaac.

Verses 3-9

- In the parallel passage this room is called the "inner sanctuary". Do you remember what goes in this room?
- From our studies about the tabernacle, whose presence resided upon this item?

Verses 10-17

- Did you know the pillars had names?
- Jachin means "He establishes".
- Boaz means "Strength is within".
- Put the two together. Beautiful.
