Numbers 5

Verses 1-4

- Why were Moses and Aaron supposed to send any unclean person outside the camp?

Verses 5-10

- Any sin mankind commits is a sin against Whom?
- How much is to be paid in restitution to a person wronged?

Verses 11-15

- Jealousy and envy are two different things. Jealousy has to do with something or someone who belongs to you. God is jealous over us, not wanting to share us with others. It is a rational jealousy for a spouse not to want to share their significant other with anyone else. Envy is about wishing you had something that someone else has, good fortune, education, a nice figure.
- According to this passage there is such a thing as a “spirit” of jealousy. Spirit can be a literal demon spirit, or spirit can signify an attitude.
- What kind of offering is mentioned here?

Verses 16-22

- In what way was the woman’s oath tested?
- How important is purity to God?

Verses 23-28

- What does bitterness cause in the woman’s body?
- If she has not defiled herself, what will her body do?

Verses 29-31

- In summary, what were the two reasons by which the woman was to be taken to the priest?

Numbers 6

Verses 1-4

- Who can take a Nazarite vow, a man or a woman?
- What is a person to abstain from if they take the Nazarite vow?

Verse 5

- How is the Nazarite to keep his hair?

Verses 6-8

- Why was a Nazarite not to touch a dead person?

Verses 9-12

- Notice verse 11 calls this a “sin because of a dead person”. It is considered a sin even though it was not his fault.

Verses 13-20

- There are many offerings mentioned in this passage, what are their names?

Verse 21

- This is the summary statement for instructions on taking the Nazarite vow.

Verses 22-27

- Don't you just love this blessing Moses and Aarons were to speak over Israel?
- Words are powerful. How do you think our relationships could be strengthened if we spoke blessings over our friends and relatives, rather than cursings?
