- According to verse 6, what were some things they were doing?

- If they are His people should they know His ordinances?

- What had the scribes done?

Verses 9-10

- Who is greedy for gain and practices deceit?
- What is the application for us?

Verse 11

- How do they heal the brokenness? With lies? With deceit? As difficult as the truth is sometimes, it heals.
- What were they saying?

Verse 12

- Were they ashamed of what they had done?
- What did they not know how to do?

Verses 13-15

- How deceived are they to believe God has done them harm?

Verses 16-20

- Why are the seasons mentioned here? Something to do with timing?

Verses 21-22

- A medicinal balm was produced in Gilead?

Verses 1-4

- What were the people like?

Verses 5-11

- What kind of animal is mentioned here? Do we usually find them in cities?

Verses 12-16

- Wormwood is bitter.

Verses 17-24

- What is the LORD like?

Verses 25-26

- “Days are coming”, so this is future for them.
- What are the nations like? What about Israel?
