- What was their argument?

### Verses 23-28

- What did Solomon discover by threatening to divide the child?

Verses 7-19

- You may have heard of Ben-hur in an old movie. Who is he in this passage?
- What was the deputy supposed to do?

Verse 20

- What was the nation like in Solomon's days?

Verse 21

- How did the people seem to feel about Solomon?

Verses 22-28

- Was Solomon's reign a time of war or a time of peace?

Verses 29-34

- Describe Solomon's wisdom. Where did it come from?
- According to verse 32, what did he speak and how many songs did he write? Can we find any of these in Scripture?
- What did men from other nations do?

## 2 Chronicles 1

Verse 1

- Who was with Solomon?

Verses 2-6

- Where did Solomon make offering?

Verses 7-13

- This is a parallel passage with 1 Kings 3.

Verses 14-17

- What kinds of things did Solomon amass?

## Psalm 72

Verses 1-20
