- What did the daughters who descended from Manasseh ask of Moses?

Verses 6-11

- Did Moses comply to the daughter's request? Why or why not?
- What kind of precedent did this set?

Verses 12-14

- What is the LORD telling Moses here? Why?

Verses 15-23

- What is God called in this passage?
- What was Moses requesting?
- Who did God appoint? What did he say about him?
- What was Moses supposed to do to him?
- What was Eleazar supposed to use to inquire of the LORD? The Urim and Thummim were like dice.
- Who was present at Joshua's commissioning?
