- Of what nationality was Doeg?

Verses 8-9

- What did David obtain from Ahimelech?

Verses 10-11

- Where did David flee?
- Did the people recognize him?

Verses 12-15

- How did David act to escape suspicion?

1 Samuel 22

Verses 1-2

- Where did David go next?
- Who came to visit him there?
- What kind of men joined David's army? How many?

Verses 3-5

- Who did he send to stay with Mizpah at Moab?
- A stronghold can be a place of protection or a place of bondage.
- What did the prophet Gad tell David?

Verses 6-10

- Does it seem like Saul is feeling sorry for himself? Does he seem paranoid?
- Who told Saul where David had gone and what he had obtained?

Verses 11-13

- Of what did Saul accuse Ahimelech? What would we call this?

Verses 14-19

- How did Ahimelech respond?
- What did Saul wish to happen with the priests?
- When the servants of Saul were unwilling to attack the priests, who did Saul's dirty work?
- How many priests did he kill? Who else did he kill?

Verses 20-23

- What report did Abiathar bring to David?

1 Samuel 23

Verses 1-5

- What did David do before he went out to fight the Philistines?
- How did this battle go?

Verses 6-14

- What did Saul plan when he heard where David went?
- What did David inquire of God?
- Review the last verse.
- Are you wondering if God anointed David as king, why he's having such a hard time with Saul? Are you wondering why God didn't just make it happen? He's teaching David to trust in Him by delivering him through a storm rather than delivering him out of it.

Verses 15-18

- Who went to encourage David at Horesh?
- What did Jonathan know about David? Remember the exchanging of the robes?
- What did Saul also know?
- What did the two men do in verse 18? They have done this before.

Verses 19-23

- What had the Ziphites planned when they came to Saul?

Verses 24-29

- When Saul had David surrounded, what word came from a messenger?

1 Samuel 24

Verses 1-7

- How many men did Saul bring with him to pursue David?
- David was so close to Saul when he went to relieve himself that David was able to take part of Saul's robe, but what does David say in verse 6?
- If you are a believer, you are God's anointed.

Verses 8-15

- How did David use this action to show Saul he was not a threat to him?

Verses 16-22

- How did Saul take this? What did he say to David?
- What does Saul realize about David in verse 20?
- What does he ask of David in verse 21? Does this remind you of the covenant with Jonathan regarding his house?
- Where did they go when they parted?
