- Remember Daniel 2 says He establishes kings and He removes kings. Are we still responsible to be involved in civics and vote?

- What would happen to the people with no grain?

- How did they consider God's law?

Verse 1

- What does playing the harlot (whore) mean in this context?

Verses 2-17

- Why would they be cast away?
- Are they still wanderers among the nations?

Hosea 10

Verses 1-5

- What were the priests like?

Verses 6-15

Hosea 11

Verse 1

- Remember “out of Egypt I called My son” for later.

Verses 2-12

- What are we told about the Holy One’s character?

Hosea 12

Verses 1-3

- Do you remember this about Jacob and Esau’s birth?

Verse 4

- Do you remember who wrestled with God? He limped the rest of his life.

Verses 5-14

Hosea 13

Verses 1-2

- What do they make for themselves?

Verses 3-16

Hosea 14

Verse 1

- Iniquity is worshiping God our way.

Verses 2-4

- Apostasy is falling away from faith. Falling away from believing.

Verses 5-9

- Observe verse 9 again. What does the LORD want us to take from this verse personally?
