Verses 1-12

- This is Mark's recount of the paralytic.
- What did the scribes say in verse 7?
- Jesus knew what they were saying, that only God can forgive sins, so what was Jesus acknowledging here?

Verse 13

- What did Jesus do out by the seashore?

Verse 14

- Levi is Matthew. What was Matthew's father's name?

Verses 15-17

- Jesus was healing people. What kind of people need a physician and healing?
- Did God come to call the righteous to repentance? Did the Pharisees also have a need for repentance though they were moral and religious?

Verses 18-20

- Do you fast when you go to a wedding or do you celebrate with the groom?

Verses 21-22

- Could this be about the old and new covenants?

Verses 23-28

- While the purpose of the Sabbath was to show us a picture of entering the rest offered us by the finished work of Jesus (see the book of Hebrews), and while there were requirements by God for observing the Sabbath, the Pharisees took it too far by adding many man-made regulations in regard to the day.
- What did Jesus have to say about this in the last two verses?
