Psalm 73

Verses 1-28

- According to verse 2 and following, why did the Psalmist come close to stumbling? What does this tell us about envy?
- What does he feel he has done in vain according to verse 13?
- What is his conclusion in the last verses?

Psalm 77

Verses 1-20

- According to verse 7, what does this psalmist feel God has done to him personally?
- Do you remember in which book we saw the sound of His thunder in the whirlwind?

Psalm 78

Verses 1-72

- According to verse 4, what would they tell their children?
- Why, according to verses 6-8?
- What do the following verses recount?
- What is the psalmist asking in verse 19? What does this mean?
- Why was God full of wrath in verses 21-22?
- In verse 24, what did He give them from heaven? Would this answer the question in verse 19?
- Review verse 37.
- What is revealed about God's character in verse 38?
- What does verse 58 mean?
- What did God do in verse 60?
- Whom did He choose as His servant in verse 70? Note: God CHOSE him.
