- God’s jealousy isn’t about Him being jealous of but jealous over. God’s jealousy is wanting to have back what belongs to Him.

- What will He vindicate?

- What will happen to the cities and the waste places? When?
- What happens when the LORD speaks?

Verses 37-38

- What will they know?

Verses 1-6

- What did the LORD show the prophet in this passage?
- What is the point of saying the bones were dry?
- After the bones came to life, what would they know?

Verses 7-10

- What happened to the breath?
- What were they when they came to life?

Verses 11-14

- What do the bones represent?
- When they come into the land of Israel, what will they know?
- What will He put into them which will make them come to life?
- What does He do if He speaks something?

Verses 15-23

- What was the prophet supposed to write on the sticks?
- What did they represent?
- What does the last phrase say?

Verses 24-28

- Who will be king over them? David has already died, so when will this happen?
- How long will God's covenant be in effect? What kind of covenant is it?
- Where will His sanctuary dwell?
- Sanctify means to set apart for a purpose.
- What will the nations know?
