April 15/Day 105

- Jumping over to some Psalms since we are going through the Scriptures chronologically. If you remember where we left off yesterday, Saul had been pursuing David and seeking to kill him.
- Psalms are books of poetry or songs.

Psalm 7

Verses 1-17

- Where does David seek refuge in this Psalm?
- What emotion does he seem to exhibit here?
- What is our application here?
- David also seeks to know if he is guilty in any way.
- Who vindicates people? What is the application for us?
- Why and in what way did David wish to be vindicated in verse 8?
- Who is a righteous judge?
- What happens to the unrepentant man in verses 12-16?
- What name for God is used here? This is the name of God which means He rules above and over all.
- Notice how David starts this Psalm then how he finishes it.

Psalm 27

Verses 1-14

- Who is our Light and our Salvation? The government? Our paychecks? Doctors? Anything else?
- Who is our defense? The Police? The justice system?
- What does David refuse to do in verse 3?
- What is his wish in verse 4?
- What can we trust Him to do for us in times of trouble?
- What are his praises like in verse 6?
- Even if our parents forsake us, Who will be with us?
- What is the path of the LORD like?
- Who had risen against David in verse 12?
- What kept him from despair?
- What does he remind himself in verse 14?

Psalm 31

Verses 1-24

- How does David describe the LORD in verses 2 and 3?
- Notice what verse 6 tells us. Do you remember what David's wife. Michal, used to disguise as David? Where might she have gotten this then?
- Who sees our affliction and our troubles?
- How does David describe his life thus far?
- What does He say about God's deliverance?
- What does He store up for those who fear Him and take refuge in Him?
- How does David start his Psalm, and how does he finish?
- How does David encourage us in the LORD today through verse 24?

Psalm 34

Verses 1-22

- How often does David say he'll praise the LORD?
- In verse 4, from how many of David's fears did the LORD deliver him?
- In verse 6, from how many troubles was the poor man delivered?
- Where is the LORD in regard to the people who fear Him? What does He do?
- Where are the eyes of the LORD in verse 15?
- Who is His face turned against?
- Where is He in verse 18?
- From how many afflictions does He deliver the righteous (those in right standing with Him)?

Psalm 52

Verses 1-9

- In what do mighty men boast? What do their tongues devise?
- Have you learned anything about trials, or enemies, or fear today? Have you learned anything about praise? Have you learned anything about God?
