Verses 41-44

- We just read about Ahab and Jehoshaphat through the battle that killed Ahab and in yesterday's readings we read about Ahab's life and reign (as well as Jezebel), now we back up and read about the reign of Jehoshaphat of Judah.
- How long had Ahab been king over Israel when Jehoshaphat became king of Judah?
- How long did Jehoshaphat reign?
- What kind of king was he? By way of contrast, what kind of king was Ahab?
- What one thing did Jehoshaphat fail to do?
- What are we told about his relationship with Ahab?

Verses 45-46

- Who is mentioned as a remnant here? Have we seen anything about this since Genesis?
- What did he do with these people?

Verses 47-53

- What was the timing of Ahaziah's reign in Israel? He was the son of Ahab.
- How long did he reign?
- What kind of king was he? Like father, like son?

2 Chronicles 18

Verses 1-3

- This is the parallel passage from the chapter above.
- What do we find out here about how Jehoshaphat made peace with Ahab?

Verses 4-34

- What are we told about God in verse 31 that we weren't told in the parallel passage?
- Did the prophet speak the truth though it wasn't what Ahab wanted to hear?
